And not until late in May do we get our April showers, which seem to have been occurring daily as we have these droplets fall from the sky. Even though the weather hasn't been all that cooperative, we were still able to get quite a bit done around the church. In the past few weeks, the work has been significant and I for one am extremely grateful for all of those who have taken part in the efforts.

The Building and Grounds Committee met several weeks ago and on the agenda was the purchase of a lawn tractor for the church, so that volunteers could come and cut the grass as needed. Lo and behold, one of the members of the committee stepped up and was able to pull some strings. By the end of that day, with the help of a couple others, we had our new used lawn tractor that was graciously donated by an anonymous friend, the tractor was in perfect working order. This donation saved the church from expensing at least a couple thousand dollars.

We also had a recent spring cleanup day, the turnout was amazing. To my recollection I've never seen as many people turn out to help take care of some of the projects that were needed to be done. We had people planting and raking, people mowing and mulching as well as people cleaning and helping with the shed project. We even had a welder out to repair the damaged handrail on the back staircase. Everyone enjoyed a few hours of fellowship and elbow grease.

We've also been able to put the front entry construction project into a higher gear. The posts and beams are up, and the roof is currently being framed. There are some details to work out in terms of how the shape of the barrel on the interior ceiling will look, but that will come soon enough. We will continue to push to make progress as best as we can.

The last thing that I would like to mention is that the appreciation and love of music has inspired one of our members to offer a donation of a new/used grand piano for our musicians to play for years to come. I cannot fully express my gratitude for this especially generous gift. We are so wonderfully blessed to receive such an offering. My hope, as well as the hope of others, is that we at St. Francis can share this gift with the community so that many can enjoy the use of this premium level instrument. We will look to expand the use of this instrument and make it available in to others within the community so that this gift can be shared beyond the Sunday morning, time slot between 10 AM and 11 AM.

And so, it is with a glad heart I would just like to thank all of you for all you have done for Saint Francis of the Tetons. The efforts which you have all put forth do not go unnoticed, and I would like to offer my praise to all of you who are working to enrich the lives of those who spend time here, as well as in the surrounding community and beyond. As always, there's more to do. We will continue to push forward to complete the projects which are at hand, and we will look for new projects for the future. 


Men's Breakfast
