Will Perkins is an internationally-known musician specializing in ragtime and stride piano. He has been performing professionally since the age of 14, and has been a featured performer at music festivals around the United States and beyond. Notably, he has been featured at the Bohem Early Jazz and

Ragtime Festival in Hungary, and the Buenos Airea Ragtime and Early Jazz Festival in Argentina.

He has also been regularly featured at the Scott Joplin Ragtime Festival, the West Coast Ragtime Festival, and


many other festivals around the country. In 2017, Rivermont Records released Will's debut album "Snowy Morning Blues", recorded on a Steinway Concert Grand at the University of Pittsburgh.

For his day job, Will is a professional piano technician, and the former owner of Signature Pianocraft. He holds diplomas in Piano Technology from the renowned North Bennet Street School in Boston, where he worked with the Boston Symphony Orchestra as a piano technician. Currently, Will resides in Idaho Falls with his wife, McKenna, and services pianos all across East Idaho and Western Wyoming."

Approved Vestry Minutes

August

Present: John Parisee, Ron Lien, Nancy Reed, Jerry Groshart, Elaine Moehring, Sarah Balben, Rod Gust on Zoom & Nancy Groshart as a guest. Nancy Parisee served as clerk via the recorded zoom meeting.



Sarah gave the opening prayer.

Treasurer

Sarah Balben presented the financials for the meeting. The Transaction Detail by Account was presented by Sarah, Sarah made a motion to accept the TDBA for the month of July, Jerry seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried. Senior Warden

Treasurer position – John spoke with two possible candidates for treasurer. He will follow up with them both.

Bylaws – Elaine stated that she has the Bylaws ready for the chancellor to review. No timeline could be given as to how long it will take for the review process. Nancy R. made a motion to approve the current Bylaws that will go to the chancellor, Jerry seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Vestry Members 2024 – 3 members of vestry will be staying on next year. Members will need to be recruited within the congregation. Any potential vestry members must be "a member in good standing". Elaine, Sarah, Ron & John will be going off vestry at the end of the year after fulfilling their obligations.

Committees & Conflict of Interest -

Committee changes that were mentioned by the bishop at his annual visit need further clarification. John has written to the bishop for clarification as to whether changes are required or recommended to our committee structure. John is also looking for guidelines in place for each of the committees. The bishop had determined at the last meeting that John & Nancy Parisee, or any other married couple, can no longer serve together on any St. Francis committees due to conflict of interest. Vestry members went on at length expressing their concerns regarding Nancy & John serving together on committees. It was noted that their concern is that a husband and wife cannot work in the same organization, and they will need to decide how best to go forward with John and Nancy being married, working, and volunteering at St. Francis as well as what is best for the administration management of the church. John felt prioritizing conflict of interest over the good works of the church would ultimately be a detriment and would pose undue obstructions to completing work within the church. Other vestry members had similar feelings and expressed that they thought husbands and wives should be able to serve together without infringements. Some vestry members expressed their concerns regarding John and his role as Sr. Warden and how his role plays out with Nancy's raises and reviews, they felt that this is a problem that needs to be addressed. The vestry will need to redefine our Outreach and Pastoral Care rules and regulations.

Piano – No one had followed up with piano appreciation homework, John will take care of it.

Grants – There are two grants available through the diocese, one through the Idaho Episcopal Foundation and the other through the Eastern Deanery. John asked for help with ideas of what we can apply for. John will follow up with this.

Convention -2 delegates and 2 wardens (Jr. & Sr), are allowed to be voting members at the Diocesan Convention. One delegate cannot attend the meeting so Jerry will go in their place since he is an alternate. We are not sure if the Deacon is required to go.

July Minutes – The first version of the minutes that were previously approved were reviewed. John noted discrepancies in those minutes which he discussed with the vestry. An edited version of the minutes was provided; Nancy R. made a motion to accept the revised minutes, Jerry seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Jr. Warden –

Ron gave a report on grass cutting at the church with the new tractor.

John mentioned that he picked up a load of barn wood for free to use for siding the shed.

Committee Reports

Outreach – Sarah presented a request for the vestry to approve the amount of \$1980.00 from the Tin Cup fund that will go to teachers within the school district for miscellaneous use. A discussion took place regarding the guidelines of money given out by committees and the concern for loose parameters. Ron made a motion to approve the \$1980.00 given to the Education Foundation with the stipulation that receipts for items purchased will be provided to the church, Nancy R. seconded the motion. 6 were in favor of the expenditure and 1 was opposed. Motion carried.

No other reports were presented.

Meeting adjourned.
