

# **Approved Vestry Minutes**

#### October



Present: John Parisee, Jerry Groshart, Elaine Moehring, Sarah Balben, Rod Gust, & Ron Lien

The meeting was recorded on Zoom, the minutes were written from the recording.

The September vestry minutes were approved by the majority via email.

**Treasurer** – Vestry reviewed the Transaction Detail by Account. It was noted that there needs to be a correction made to an Eat & Meet expenditure, change it to say the expenditure was for September Eat & Meet, not October. A correction needs to be made to the cleaner's wages; it was incorrectly entered by the accounting firm as Sexton wages. A question came up about where Angie's salary was in the report, Nancy P. had said that the payroll firm lumps the two salaries together for reporting. Rod made a motion to approve the TDBA with the corrections mentioned above and a clarification to the salaries, Ron seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried.

#### Senior Warden

By-laws – More changes are still in order. John will have a discussion with the bishop so we can get clarification from him regarding multiple areas.

Possible Vestry Members for 2024 –A nominating committee will need to recruit new members. A discussion took place about how the Sr. Warden is elected to vestry and who should be on the nominating committee, John will ask the bishop for clarification.

Bishop's Retreat Review – All enjoyed the retreat, they found it inspiring and thought it was a great way to get to know each other.

Vestry Minutes – John asked that when the minutes are sent out via email, vestry members review them and get any edits in right away. The minutes are sent out via email so that the parish can review them soon after the meeting. Only approved minutes can be published in the newsletter. The committee discussed whether or not to keep approving the minutes via email, nothing was decided. John asked that if sending edits in, they should be presented clearly and concisely.

Stewardship 2024 – October 22<sup>nd</sup> is the kick-off day for stewardship. Jim Rein will be in charge.

Committees – John will ask chairs of the committees to get back to him with a vision for their committee along with quidelines and their thoughts on how they are functioning.

#### Junior Warden

Ron gave a report, he stated that there are new LED light fixtures to be installed throughout the church.

#### Committees

Sarah gave a verbal report on events taking place and coming up at the church for the Outreach Committee.

No other committees gave reports.

Other Business – John said that the church audit is due at the end of the month. The audit should be performed by the bookkeeper and two volunteers. Sarah volunteered to do the audit; she will find someone on the finance committee to help.

The next meeting date is November 14<sup>th</sup>.
