# St. Francis Vestry

#### **Approved Vestry Minutes** December 2023

Present: John Parisee, Ron Lien, Jerry Groshart, & Dan Baxter as Treasurer, Elaine Moehring & Sarah Balben attended via Zoom.

The meeting was recorded on Zoom, the minutes were written from the recording.

The November vestry minutes were approved by the majority via email, Elaine abstained from voting on the minutes.

Treasurer - John reviewed and presented the Transaction Detail by Account. It was noted that an outreach expense category will need to be amended. A motion was made by Ron to accept the TDBA for November, Jerry seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried. Debit card account - Dan said that we will be phasing out our old debit card account. In the future we will be using the new church credit card. Dan will schedule meetings for the Finance and Endowment committees.

#### Senior Warden -

Bylaws - John said that there will be one more review of the Bylaws, hopefully they will be ready for the Annual Meeting. Nomination Committee - Sarah announced that she is willing to stay on and take over what is left of Angie Warner's term on vestry, 2 years. Ron said he has decided to stay on another 3 year term. Both John and Jerry will stay on another year. A discussion took place for possible candidates for 2024.

Committee Descriptions – John asked for committee guidelines & descriptions, including protocol for each committee. This description should include what each committee does and how they get their work done. John will follow up with committee chairs.

Review of visit with Mother Lea Colvill – The vestry discussed concern over having someone that we don't know coming in and guiding our church. A self-analysis of our parish should be done by the incoming vestry. Members expressed their desire to look at our budget once we find out what her commitment would be and how much she would want to be paid. The vestry decided to table further discussions until after the annual meeting so that the new vestry members could be in place.

Raises and Bonuses to employees - The vestry discussed increasing Angie Warner's Christmas bonus and her hourly wage. Jerry made a motion to increase her wages, Elaine seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried.

John made the motion to increase Angie's Christmas bonus, Jerry seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried.



A motion was made to increase Nancy Parisee's wages. John stepped out of the room. A conversation took place but there was no decision to increase her wages.

John made a motion to increase the Musician wages per service, (Elaine and Ron recused themselves from voting), Jerry seconded the motion, all in favor (without Elaine & Ron), motion carried. John made a motion to increase the Musician Christmas bonuses (Elaine & Ron recused themselves from voting), Jerry seconded the vote, all in favor (without Elaine & Ron), motion carried.

Junior Warden - Ron gave a report stating that the crack in the basement floor has been fixed.

Ron installed almost all of the new LED light fixtures throughout the church.

We have hired Choice Property Mgt. to plow this winter.

New signs are up in our parking lot asking that parking throughout the winter if for church members only.

The Building & Grounds committee will be meeting on December 17<sup>th</sup>.

**Committees** - No written minutes or reports were submitted for review.

John announced that Gayle Lien is the new Worship Committee chair.

Sarah gave a verbal update on the recent Food Drive. She stated that the Sing a Long is coming up. She stated that there were outreach requests during the month of November.

Jerry gave a verbal update on the Pastoral Care committee.

The next meeting date is January 9<sup>th</sup>

#### Additional Minutes Given to the December minutes given at the January vestry meeting -

The members who met after the video was turned off retracted any raises given previously so they could look at the raises in relation to the 2024 budget. Ron made a motion to retract all employee and musician raises, Jerry seconded the motion, all in favor (except John who was not present), motion carried.

#### Approved Vestry Minutes January 2024

Present: John Parisee, Elaine Moehring Jerry Groshart, Sarah Balben, & Dan Baxter as Treasurer, Ron Lien attended via Zoom

The meeting was recorded on Zoom, the minutes were written from the recording.

The December vestry minutes were not approved.

**Treasurer** - Dan reviewed the financial report and the financials prepared for vestry.

The Transaction Detail by Account was reviewed for December. Dan recommended that the bonuses are reflected before the expenditures are approved. A motion was made by Sarah to accept the TDBA with the exception that the 2 outstanding bonus checks in the financials need to be resolved and need to be added to the administration wage bonuses, Elaine seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried. Dan said the Finance Committee met. Minutes of the meeting, along with the proposed 2024 budget were distributed to vestry members. Dan presented the 2024 budget to the vestry members for their recommendation. The vestry had discussions on the pledge and pate amounts as well as employee compensation, they did not vote on the budget.

A discussion regarding CD's came up, Dan said there would need to be a recommendation from the Finance Committee to purchase CD's.

#### Senior Warden -

Nominations for Vestry – John thanked the two outgoing members of vestry for their time. He said that there are two people, who had previously served on vestry, that committed to serve again.

Senior Warden - John said that was willing to stay on another year as the Senior Warden. He stated that he had emailed the bishop regarding protocol for electing Senior Wardens, he has not heard back from him.

The Annual Meeting will take place on January 21, 2024.

Junior Warden 2024 – Ron said he was not interested in being the Junior Warden.

Employee reviews & raises – The Zoom recording was turned off for this part of the meeting. John reported that Ron made a motion to accept a cost of living raise of 4% for the two church employees, Jerry seconded the motion. John recused himself from voting for Nancy's raise. All in favor (except John for Nancy's raise), motion carried.

December vestry minutes – December Minutes were updated to include discussions and voting during the unrecorded period of the meeting.

Junior Warden - Ron reported that the front entry roof was shingled by John and Tom Warren.

He stated that we have been saving money on snow plowing due to the lack of snow.

The Building & Grounds committee will talk about replacing the Rennai heater in the sanctuary.

The egress window for the sleeping room in the basement came in.

**Committees -** Only the Finance Committee submitted written minutes for review.

Worship – John gave a verbal update and said that the Worship Committee is going well.

Outreach/Fellowship – Sarah gave a verbal update on Tin Cup expenditures during December.

Pastoral Care – Jerry said cards went out.

Finance – A verbal report wasn't required as Treasurer Report covered the same topics.

Endowment – John stated that we need another person on the Endowment Committee for 2024.

Building & Grounds – Ron said that the committee will discuss the front entry at their next meeting.

John thanked everyone for another year on vestry.

The next meeting date in February is scheduled for February 13<sup>th</sup>.
