
Join Us For A Potluck Lunch




Left: Students of Selena Miskin delighted many in the community with a children's musical recital on May 19th.

We Need You!

Your help is needed to fill our weekly volunteer positions including Lector, Greeter/Usher, Refreshments & Altar Guild.

We volunteers!

Lector - This person reads the first lesson during our worship service. Greeter/Usher - This job varies depending on whether the service is Morning Prayer or Holy Eucharist. When having Morning Prayer, the job of the Greeter/Usher is to welcome people at the beginning of the service, hand out bulletins, and count the number of people at the service and record it in the red book at the lectern. During Holy Eucharist, the Greeter/Usher will perform the duties above as well as bring up the communion gifts, along

with another volunteer, collect the offering, and then bring the offering up during the Doxology. **Refreshments** - We have an open potluck refreshment time each Sunday, anyone can bring something to share. Help is needed to make coffee each Sunday, if you can help please email the office. **Altar Guild** - Our Altar Guild team has various tasks that are needed to prepare for the worship service each Sunday.
